EXHIBITOR RULES

Northeast Guitar Expo (NGE) booth registrations are confirmed by receipt of the executed Exhibitor Agreement, accompanied by check, money order, PayPal or cash payment. (First come, first paid, first served).

Each booth come with one 6-foot draped table, 2 chairs and two exhibitor badges.

Names of booth workers must be submitted with application, and each person must produce identification at check-in to obtain a badge. Badges must be worn at all times. Extra passes are available and must be approved by NGE.

Only one firm or entity may occupy each booth. This includes casual instrument traders.

Noise levels will be monitored and controlled throughout the show. If deemed necessary, abuse of noise levels may result in loss of electrical connection.

Neither NGE nor the venue will assume responsibility for any theft, damage, accidents or problems that might occur during the course of the show.

All non-exhibitors who distributes literature of any kind will be removed from the building.

Exhibitors may begin to move into the venue at 7am. All booths must be ready by 10am. No late set-ups. The show doors will open promptly at 11am.

Exhibitors must furnish receipts with all sales and trades, without regard to size or value of items. Customers are required to present these receipts to remove items from the venue.

NGE management may refuse a booth application for any reason.

Sales or display of illegal, unlicensed or “bootlegged” goods is expressly prohibited. This includes but is not limited to audio, video, printed and/or manufactured items.
